

### PART III – SUPPLY

- A. **Exchanging Uniform Items:** Those cadets who require uniform issue will report to the Supply Officer for sizing. Those that have outgrown or lost various uniform parts are to report to supply to arrange an appointment for re-issue. ### PART IV – TRAINING
